Please find attached an outline drawing of the proposed development of Prospect House, Hexham Road by Dillon (opposite Dillon's Fish and Chip Shop). We believe that a planning application has been submitted to Newcastle City Planning. This image and further documentation was supplied by Mr Dhillon and is sent to you with Mr Dhillon's consent.

Local residents have requested that through Throckley Residents Action Group we inform you that THEY are fully supportive of this build. THEY consider this build to be in keeping with the environment and to a standard which will raise the profile of Throckley village.

Our question is – Why are ESH group continuing to insist that their design is necessary to meet Government requirements for an 'energy efficient' style of development when judging by the proposal for Dillon's this is not the case. This only reinforces our intention to continue to oppose the current build proposal which is not in sympathy with the surrounding environment.
